The hire charge for these karts is HK\$ 50,000 but this fee will be waived if the team raises in excess of HK\$ 50k in sponsorship. 3. Entry fees: \$6,125 for the first kart
\$4,594 for subsequent karts
\$3,063 for schools, charities etc
\$2,297 for schools, charities etc subsequent karts
CHEQUES SHOULD BE MADE PAYABLE TO “Association of Round Tables in HK Charitable Foundation”.
(Charity donation and sponsorship cheques should be made out to the same payee).
4. Categories: Each team should enter its kart into one category under each class heading – this marks a change from previous years. The team must qualify for those categories according to the rules issued by the HKHPVA for Pedal 2008.
5. Prizes: All teams entered are eligible for the overall 1st, 2nd and 3rd place prizes on the basis of overall distance travelled over the course of the race.
 - “Construction Class” prizes will be awarded on the basis of overall distance covered by karts entered into each construction class. Karts’ categories will be verified by the Chief Scrutineer at the time of safety scrutineering prior to the race. The Chief Scrutineers’ ruling as to construction will be final and not subject to appeal.
 - “Industry Tournament” prizes will be awarded on the basis of overall distance covered by karts entered into each Industry class. A minimum of three karts is needed to open an industry class for prizegiving purposes.
 - “Engines Tournament” prizes will be awarded on a “best of the rest” basis to karts in each category having travelled the furthest distance, but not having yet won an award.
 - Other prizes: The organisers and competitors have, over the years, endowed a number of special prizes for competitors in the event. It is the general view of the organising committee that these prizes should be awarded to teams not having already won “Construction Class” or “Industry Tournament” trophies. Teams, Team Sponsors and event sponsors are welcome to endow trophies for presentation, in consultation with the organising committee – to avoid overlap with existing trophies.
6. Racing is subject to the Hong Kong 24hour Grand Prix Racing Rules (the Rules) as compiled by Hong Kong Human Powered Vehicle Association (HKHPVA), adopted by the Association of Round Tables in Hong Kong, Round Table 10, (Table 10) and updated from time to time by the organizing committee.
